# BUS INFORMATION

## Bus Pass Information

Each elementary school will distribute bus passes during September when the appropriate fee has been paid. DPM students will use their student ID cards as their bus pass. The appropriate bus routes will be placed on the ID cards when the appropriate fee has been paid. No student will be permitted to ride without a bus pass.

## Bus Route Parameters

Questions regarding the designation of bus routes and stops, which were developed in conjunction with our transportation company, should be directed to Maureen Quaid at 847-615-4476.

Any route or stop change requests must be submitted to the district in writing and can be emailed to: [mquaid@ifschools.net](mailto:mquaid@ifschools.net) Changes to bus routes or stops can take up to two weeks to be implemented.

## Bus Registration/Billing

A \$50 administrative fee will be assessed on full year riders who choose to pay for one semester at a time. Students riding the bus for one semester only will not pay the administrative fee. Once again, only those students who are registered and have paid the bus fee will be permitted to ride a bus.

The district is excited to announce the "10 Pass" package is now available as a Family Pass and may be rolled over through 8<sup>th</sup> Grade. The 10 Pass is available for the occasional bus rider. This package is for students who do not regularly ride the bus but on occasion need transportation service. The package may only be purchased once per child, but the tickets may be used by any child in the family. The package includes 10 one-way passes for rides on a scheduled run. A transportation change notice must accompany each ticket. This will be provided in your "10 Pass" package.

## **Expected Bus Behavior Agreement**

### **Contract for District 67 Students**

District 67 is committed to maintaining positive, responsible, respectful, and safe cultures in our schools and on each school bus. In school district 67 we strive to create and maintain **BODACIOUS BUS FAMILIES**.

#### **Expected Bus Behaviors**

1. Arrive at bus stop five minutes early
2. Be respectful and follow the bus driver's instructions.
3. Stay out of the street when waiting for the bus.
4. Be respectful of others and private property. **Bullying of any type is not allowed** (see definition of bullying below).
5. Form lines five feet from bus when boarding; do not push.
6. Watch your step, and use the handrail when getting on and off the bus.
7. Use "indoor" voices while on the bus.
8. Keep aisles clear. Sit facing forward at all times while bus is in motion.
9. Be completely quiet when the bus stops at railroad crossings so that the bus driver can hear.
10. Eating and drinking not allowed on bus.
11. Use respectable words and actions on the bus.
12. Keep head, hands, feet, and possessions inside the bus at all times.
13. Pay attention to your stop so you know when to get off the bus.
14. After you get off the bus, go directly to your after-school destination.

The act of "bullying" can be described as the persistent, repeated and/or chronic pattern of physical, verbal, psychological harassment and the continual harming of another person within an unequal power relationship.

#### **Consequences**

It is expected that each of these behaviors will be maintained. If expected behavior is not exhibited, one or more of the following consequences will occur (not in any order):

- verbal warning from bus driver
- misconduct report from driver sent to principal
- talk with principal
- student/teacher/principal conference
- parent call
- parent conference
- student/teacher/parent/driver/principal conference
- student may receive detention or sent home
- student may receive an in-school suspension
- student may receive a suspension from school
- student busing privileges may be suspended
- action deemed appropriate by administrator, as may be determined by the circumstances
