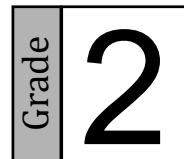




Understanding Your Child's Report Card

Trimester Three Expectations for Learning



The following information is provided to parents for a more complete understanding of student learning. The *phrases in italics* outline general learning topics that remain the same on each of the trimester report cards. The bulleted points give specific information about the expectations for learning during this trimester.

Math

Demonstrates # sense

- Identifies fractions as equals parts of a whole or a set
- Understands place value expanded notation to the thousands place

Understands concepts of measurement & geometry

- Tells time in 5 minute increments
- Measures to the nearest inch and centimeter
- Selects and uses appropriate measurement tools

Understands money concepts

- Solves addition money word problems up to \$10
- Makes change up to \$1

Applies problem solving strategies

- Solves multiplication word problems can use pictures or manipulatives

Understands and uses operations with whole numbers

- Subtracts 2 digit numbers with regrouping
- Demonstrates understanding of division via equal sharing

Knows and applies addition facts

- Adds 40 correct facts (sums to 18) in two minutes

Knows and applies subtraction facts

- Subtracts 40 correct facts (differences to 9) in two minutes

Social Studies Report Card Descriptors

Compare and contrast elements of communities past and present

- Describes life during the Westward movement
- Compares the life of a Pioneer child to own life

Demonstrates an understanding of geography

- Names both natural and manmade landmarks in the United States

Reading Report Card Descriptors

Uses multiple decoding strategies

- Applies letter sound knowledge to decode unknown words
- Uses context clues to decode unknown words

Reading with fluency and expression

- Reads at least 90 words per minutes using a second grade level text
- Uses appropriate phrasing and inflection

Demonstrates vocabulary growth

- Understands homonyms
- Uses context clues to define unknown words

Uses reading comprehension strategies to gain meaning from the text

- Infers meaning
- Supports opinion using evidence from the text
- Identifies cause and effect relationships

Responds to literature

- Writes a response to questions about a text

Writing

Writes legibly

- Writes legibly in manuscript using proper spacing and letter formation

Understands and applies writing conventions

- Capitalizes proper nouns
- Punctuates using apostrophes in contractions and singular possessives
- Writes using complete sentences
- Punctuates friendly letter

Elaborates ideas using a variety of strategies

- Uses descriptive and figurative language
- Uses time order words

Engages in the writing process

- Publishes writing
- Writes a friendly letter, poetry and a personal narrative

Spells assigned Word Wall Words

Applies strategies and correct spelling of assigned words
