- Develops a spirit of cooperation among the districts that participate in Shared Services as well as with the area private schools and neighboring school districts and the City of Lake Forest.
- Is a visible leader who is connected to and willing to be involved with the community and who appreciates the culture and traditions that exist, yet has a compelling vision for the future that can be strategically implemented.
- Is a creative problem solver who is innovative and reaches beyond educational practice in seeking solutions.
