Expected Bus Behavior Agreement

Contract for District 67 Students

District 67 is committed to maintaining positive, SAFE, RESPECTFUL, and RESPONSIBLE cultures in our schools and on each school bus. District 67 strives to create and maintain **BODACIOUS BUS FAMILIES**.

Expected Bus Behaviors

1. Arrive at bus stop five minutes early.
2. Be respectful and follow the bus driver's instructions.
3. Stay out of the street when waiting for the bus.
4. Be respectful of others and private property. **Bullying of any type is not allowed** (see definition of bullying below).
5. Form lines five feet from bus when boarding; pushing is not allowed.
6. Watch your step, and use the handrail when getting on and off the bus.
7. Use "indoor" voices while on the bus.
8. Keep aisles clear. Sit facing forward at all times while bus is in motion.
9. Be completely quiet when the bus stops at railroad crossings so that the bus driver can hear.
10. Eating and drinking is not allowed on bus.
11. Use respectable words and actions on the bus.
12. Keep head, hands, feet, and possessions inside the bus at all times.
13. Pay attention to your stop so you know when to get off the bus.
14. After you get off the bus, go directly to your after-school destination.

The act of "bullying" can be described as the persistent, repeated and/or chronic pattern of physical, verbal, psychological harassment and the continual harming of another person within an unequal power relationship.

Consequences

It is expected that each of these behaviors will be maintained. If expected behavior is not exhibited, one or more of the following consequences will occur (not in any order):

- verbal warning from bus driver
- misconduct report from driver sent to principal
- talk with principal
- student/teacher/principal conference
- parent call
- parent conference
- student/teacher/parent/driver/principal conference
- student may receive detention or sent home
- student may receive an in-school suspension
- student may receive a suspension from school
- student abusing privileges may be suspended
- action deemed appropriate by administrator, determined by the circumstances
