The Education Committee met on May 20.

The Education Committee approved the minutes from April meeting

Tri-District Assessment Committee – Dr Griffith gave an update of the Tri-District Assessment Committee. The information gave the committee a sense of how our students are performing at the high school.

Dashboard – Mr. Schumacher gave the committee an update on the status of the dashboard. The indicators tie back to our Vision Statements. Where possible, benchmarks will be added to the indicators. It was discussed that this project is work-in-process and we need to go live soon and adjust as we go.

Technology Update – Mr. Schumacher presented the committee with the Mission and Belief statements from the Instructional Technology Group. The committee provides some minor feedback.

Summer Curriculum – Mr. Hendrikson gave an updated on the planned activities for summer curriculum projects. Two years ago, the direction for the summer activities was redirected to better align with the curriculum and this trend continues with the summer 2010 work.

Middle School Schedule – Mr. Hendrikson gave the committee the over view of the changes planned for the 7th an 8th grades for the 2010 -2011 year. The schedule was recommended by the staff that has helped to improve this for our students and staff.

Mandarin – Mr. Hendrikson gave a short overview of the work that continues with the Michigan State University and gave us a picture introduction to the new teacher for Mandarin in the fall

Presentation Schedule – The committee then discussed the dates for the fall meetings and the schedule that the Education Committee previews the reports to the board. The committee recommended a couple minor changes to help ensure data was available at the appropriate time.
