Annual Indicators

- Disciplinary Incidents-Annual discipline report for grades 5-8

Representative Activities

- Use a collaborative model, a broad based committee and best practice research to review current bus safety practices to establish or revise procedures and protocols.
- Review results from the school-wide behavior support survey and 2010 Illinois Youth Survey and make recommendations for future implementation.
- Coordinate Emotional Wellness classroom and school activities directly to the 2020 Vision model established by the Tri-District Steering Committee.
- Implement the annual action plan set forth by the Emotional Wellness district and school committees and assess impact.
- Prepare for implementation of WEB (Where Everyone Belongs) middle school transition program for the 2011-12 school year.
