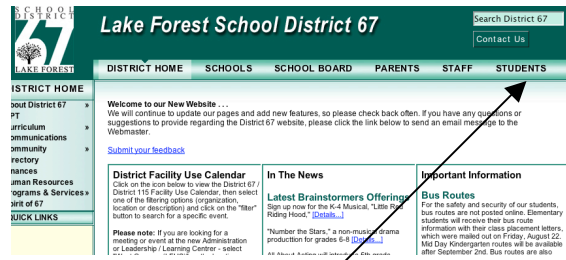


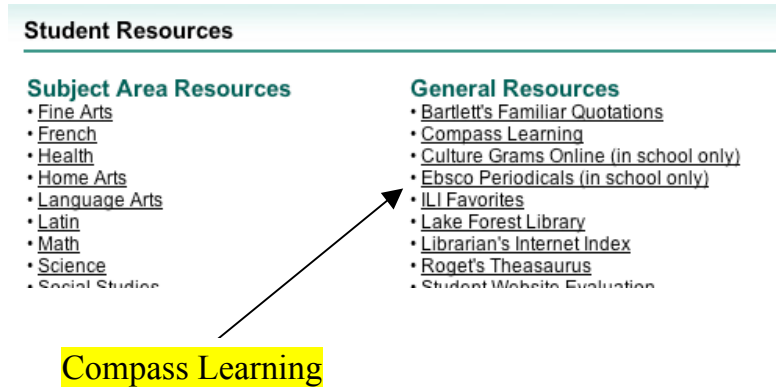
Using Compass Learning at Home

1. To access Compass Learning go to the district website at <http://www.lf67.org>. In the pull down menu select Resources and then pull down to Student Resources.

2. Under General Resources select Compass Learning.

3. On the Compass Learning site you will need to enter your student's User Name and Password.

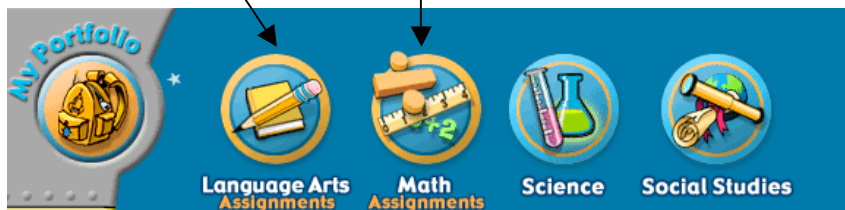
User Name: astudent

- Be sure to use the **log in** button and not the return key.
- **The school should be Odyssey.**

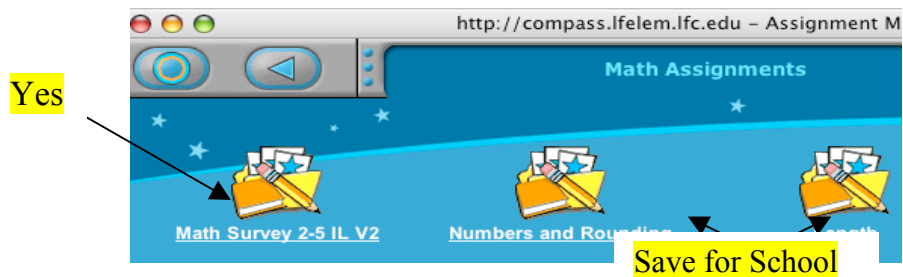
4. Please click on the subject area you would like to work during your session (**Language Arts or Math**).

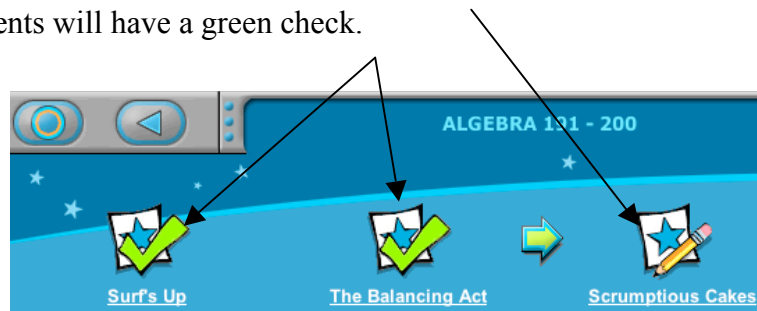

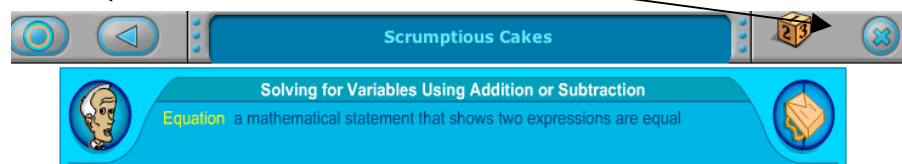
assigned by NWEA have titles that end with numbers. Folders without digits have been assigned by me and should only be done in school.



- White titles with lines under them can be selected for the student to work on. White titles without lines cannot be selected until the student has completed other assignments in the series. Assignments that **need to be done** will have a pencil. Completed assignments will have a green check.



- The **arrow** on the left allows you to go back to the previous screen. To end your session, **click the X**. This will close the program and you will need to log back in once this button has been selected.



Some of the lessons will save where your child left off and others will not. It is best to finish each assignment. That way their work will not be lost. Keep in mind that some of the lessons will present information that they have not been taught before. It is OK to help them in these situations.

8. The exercises in this program are all set up differently. Sometimes students may type the answer, other times they may click and drag, and sometimes they may highlight items. Many of the directions are given orally so if you want to help them, you may need to use the back arrow key to listen to the directions.

9. On the home page there is a **backpack**. If you click the backpack you will be able to see your child's progress. The square with **blue** in the status column will tell you if the assignment is finished. If the assignment type has a **gold dot or Q** your child will be graded on that exercise. When you are in the backpack area you will need to click the circle to return to the assignment page.
